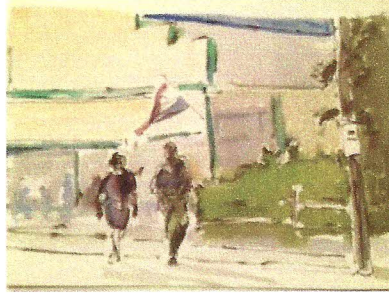


HOWARD PARK PAINTING WORKSHOP
